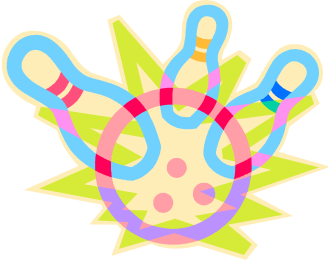

In case of illness or injury, I hereby give permission to the advisor in charge to procure treatment for my child. I hereby release Temple Beth Sholom and all its affiliates, including advisors and chaperones, whether paid or unpaid, for all liability resulting from accident or injury during this event, whether it be at a location or during the commute, and release same from all liability resulting from loss or damage of property due to theft or accident. I understand that if my child breaks any rules set forth in the Code of Conduct outlined by the advisor in charge (including possession of cigarettes, illegal drugs, or alcohol), they may be subject to disciplinary action by the advisor in charge, including but not limited to, expulsion from any event, in which case it is my responsibility to pick them up from the event immediately on the request of the advisor in charge, with no refund or monies paid. All participants must remain at the event for the full duration. Late arrival to or early departure from any event must be agreed upon by the advisor in charge ahead of time and must include parental consent. In signing this permission form, I also understand that I consent to the photographing, reproduction, use, and retention of photographs, film, and/or video of my child(ren) taken by and/or for Temple Beth Sholom for use in education, publicity, and promotional activities in any and all publications and other media without limitation or reservation. Temple Beth Sholom shall retain all negatives.

CODE OF CONDUCT

I will promote the creation of a religious youth community based on mutual respect and a sense of personal well-being. I will treat others with *kavod* (honor and respect) because we are created *b'tzelem Elohim* (in the image of God). I have read the following rules, designed to promote the health and safety of all event participants, and have indicated my complete acceptance by my signature and that of my parent/guardian.

I will not possess, consume, or distribute alcoholic beverages, other than that served by adult leadership for Jewish sacramental purposes, even if I am of legal drinking age.

I will not possess, use, or distribute any illegal drug or drug paraphernalia.

I will not smoke or consume or distribute tobacco products at any time during the event.

I will attend and participate fully in the entire event, unless otherwise agreed upon with the Youth Advisor.

I will arrive on time, stay until the end, and remain on the event premises at all times.

I will not bring or use any weapons, firearms, or anything that may be construed as a weapon.

I will not commit any illegal act. I understand that vandalism, disturbing the peace, or other inappropriate behavior as determined by the adult leadership in accordance with the youth leadership will not be tolerated. I understand that I will have to pay for any damage that I cause. I understand that no gambling is allowed, except for fundraisers approved by the adult leadership.

I understand that no guests are allowed at any event, unless the adult leadership grants permission in advance, and that any unauthorized guests will be asked to leave immediately.

I will not participate in any activities that could be deemed as hazing, sexually harassing, demeaning, or hurtful.

I agree to refrain from inappropriate sexual behavior.

I agree to abide by any additional rules, pertinent to a specific event, which may be announced, and to accept the consequences of their violation.

I understand that these rules of behavior apply from the time I leave home for the event, during the event itself, and until I return home after the event.

We understand that part of the youth group experience involves activities, group living arrangements and interactions that may be new to my child. These things come with certain risks and uncertainties beyond what my child may be used to dealing with at home. I am aware of these risks, and I am assuming them on behalf of my child. I realize that no environment is risk free and so I have instructed my child on the importance of abiding by the Code of Conduct. My child and I both agree that he or she is familiar with these rules and will obey them. We further understand that sanctions imposed by the Youth Advisor for violation could include immediate expulsion from the event, at the expense of the parent or guardian.

My signature, and the signature of my parent/guardian, affirm my agreement to the rules and policies of this Code of Conduct.
