<p>SCHOOL COMMUNICATOR Welcomes new members to the school via phone or email, Works with Parent Association Chair to create emails to communicate to school parents throughout the year regarding important info, events, notices, volunteer recruitment, etc. Attends PA meetings</p>	
<p>FUNDRAISING COMMITTEE CHAIR Plans and executes at least one large and a few small activities to help raise funds for the school. Assists with silent auction at the Purim Carnival. Some ideas are an ECC family garage sale, dinners at restaurants that split revenue with ECC, etc.</p>	
<p>SOCIAL COMMITTEE CHAIR Plans activities that encourage parent participation and promote ECC community spirit. This could include "Women & Wine" nights, "Dads Night Out", as well as a family outing (such as a trip to Tanaka Farms). Other ideas are a "Parent Survival Night" where TBS provides childcare and parents go out together, game nights, and more.</p>	
<p>SCHOLASTIC BOOKS COORDINATOR Distributes monthly book flyers to classrooms, approves online orders, and sorts and delivers books to classrooms upon arrival.</p>	

<p>FALL FESTIVAL CHAIR Organizes a morning experience to celebrate fall. Plans and runs this experience for the children. (i.e. pile of leaves to jump in, fall related arts & crafts, fall foods to taste, etc.)</p>	
<p>BAKE SALE CHAIR Organizes the baking and selling of baked goods to raise funds for TBS ECC</p>	
<p>LATKE FACTORY/HANUKKAH FUN DAY CHAIR Plans and coordinates a morning experience for our children including preparing, making, and eating latkes, preparing Hanukkah crafts and activities (works with Cindi on this event)</p>	
<p>HAMANTASCHEN FACTORY CHAIR Coordinates the set-up, making of hamantaschen with the children, and clean-up. Provides assistance to Cindi Dubrow to oversee/run the event.</p>	
<p>PURIM CARNIVAL PRESCHOOL CHAIR Heads up the preschool participation in the Purim Carnival. The preschool chair and volunteers work in collaboration with the Religious School and in recruiting day-of volunteers, planning set-up, games, food, silent auction, entertainment, clean-up, themed baskets, etc.</p>	
<p>PASSOVER COMMITTEE CHAIR Plans and organizes a morning event filled with Passover sensory experiences (i.e. a skit put on by parents, a matzah tasting station, a Passover craft, smelling of horseradish, reading Passover stories)</p>
